IPA REGIONAL FORUMS

IPA Regional Forums are shared learning opportunities for foundations and their key community partners. They take place biennially, in five regions around the state. Affinity groups connect members who share a funding interest or professional role through in-person networking or learning events and include the following:

Family Philanthropy Forum

This group consists of family foundations located in Central Indiana.

Greater Indianapolis Program Officers (GIPO)

This group consists of program officers (or those with grant management responsibilities) working in the greater Indianapolis area.

Health Funders Group

This group consists of Indiana foundations concerned with or funding issues related to health.

Indiana Blacks in Philanthropy (IBIP)

Established for Black grantmakers and trustees, this group provides peer support, fosters professional development, mentors for students and young professionals, and expands philanthropy within Black communities.

Large Private Foundation CEOs

This group consists of leaders from Indiana's largest private foundations.

Young Leaders in Philanthropy (YLIP)

This group consists of emerging grantmaking professionals between the ages of 21-40 (give or take a few years), located in the greater Indianapolis area.
