Through the first round of Boone County COVID-19 Nonprofit Grants of \$30,000, a major impact has already been made in our local communities during COVID-19.

EDUCATION & AWARENESS

The Boone County Health Department is providing direction & education for our leaders & residents.



FREE MEALS

Boys & Girls Club of Boone County has served 1,185 meals, with the daily # steadily increasing to 250+ per day. They've also launched a series of virtual programs to provide connection for youth members who are separated from their friends, school, and the Club.



TRANSPORTATION & ELDERLY CARE

Boone County Senior Services, Inc. has assisted 53 clients, visited 41 homes, & continues to make check-in calls to 80-100 Boone County elderly residents to assess their situation and fill need. They've averaged 40 trips/day to anyone in need for transportation, medical appointments, grocery pick up, work, or other essential errands.

Love Inc. has given out 680 meals through their pantries. They've partnered with Mental Health of America BC and Shalom House to provide groceries for 195 meals to families and delivered to shut ins. They're providing blankets & pillows for the Boone County Health Dept.

Shalom House continues to serve 120+ warm meals on Tuesdays & Saturdays, and are delivering meals and non-perishable goods to shut ins. They are also launching the kids sack lunch program for 3 weeks.

The Caring Center is providing pre-boxed meals to families and are seeing around 30 families per day.



WELLNESS CHECKS & GROCERY DELIVERY

The ARC of Greater Boone County is checking in with the people they serve to make sure needs are taken care of. They've partnered with local high school youth to offer free grocery delivery and pick-up. They're making masks for their staff with the goal to eventually make enough to share with other organizations in need.
