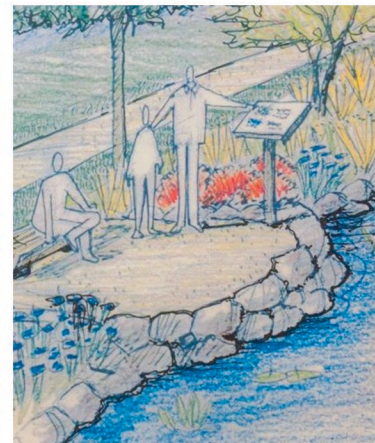
WHAT IS IT?

A crowdgranting funding program created by the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) to create new or activate underused public space. The program is open to municipalities and non-profits that are located in Indiana communities or neighborhoods which contain a traditional downtown or neighborhood commercial node.
